

# 2026 KNOWN Women's Retreat

## Frequently Asked Questions

How many ladies will share a room?

Rooms are double occupancy (two per room). You're welcome to note a preferred roommate on your registration form, and we'll do our best to accommodate.

Will I have to share a bed?

Each room offers separate beds—either two queens or bunk-style—so no one will need to share a bed.

Do I need to provide linens?

Bathroom towels and bed linens are provided in each room.

What are the bathrooms like?

Each room is hotel-style and is equipped with a private bathroom with shower, toilet and sink.

How will rooms be assigned?

Room assignments will be based on need, one- or two-night stay, and the preferences you note in your registration; if none are specified, the committee will thoughtfully assign rooms.

What time is check in?

Check in begins on Friday, November 6 starting at 4pm. There will be a welcome and dinner starting around 6:30pm. *Final times and schedule will be sent out this fall.*

What if I don't want to stay the night?

Overnight stay is optional; however, due to the cost of the retreat, the registration fee remains the same whether or not you choose to stay overnight.

Can I come for just Saturday?

Yes—Saturday attendance is included in the full retreat registration. The cost covers Friday night through Saturday, and you may add a second night if you'd like to stay through Sunday.

Will there be other groups/churches at Inspiration Hills?

Our Faith United Woven Retreat is in our own dedicated space, the Eagle Crest Lodge. Meals, meetings, and rooms will all be in this building. There are other activities happening around the large Inspiration Hills campus, but we are excited to have the intimacy of the Eagle Crest Lodge and surrounding grounds for our weekend together.

### *How do payment plans work?*

Payment plans are available for registrations completed on or before July 15th. If you are registering after July 15th and need a payment plan option, please reach out to the Woven Committee to discuss arrangements.

If you prefer to use a payment plan, it will work as follows:

#### PAYMENT #1:

\$50 Deposit due at Registration for One Night

\$115 Deposit due at Registration for Two Nights

#### PAYMENT #2

\$50 Due June 30th

#### PAYMENT #3 (Final Payment)

\$50 Due July 30th

Our registration team will do their best to send you email reminders for your payments. We appreciate your punctuality and/or communication (if needed) for payments.

### *Are there scholarships available?*

If you would like to attend the retreat but are concerned about meeting the financial obligation, we would like to hear from you. It is our desire and hope to help assist those ladies who would like to attend but find that the cost creates an obstacle. Please contact a member of the Woven Committee to discuss.

### *Can I donate funds to help reduce registration costs for those who may not have the means to attend?*

Yes, and thank you for your heart of generosity. We have a question on the registration form where you can indicate your desire to give and select the amount. This will be added to your total cost and can be paid through the Church Center platform at the time of registration.

### *Can I invite a friend that doesn't go to our church?*

You are welcomed and encouraged to invite a friend, even if she doesn't attend Faith United. The retreat content and overall pace of the weekend is designed for adult women (18+).

## *Cancellation Policy*

We are required to pay in full for the retreat on August 1st.

With your completed registration, we are reserving a space for you and committing to pay Inspiration Hills for your room. Should your plans change unexpectedly before July 30, please notify us immediately, and we will process a cancellation. Our registration commitment to Inspiration Hills will be turned in on August 1st. After this date, we will only be able to add

rooms for late registrations, but we will not be able to cancel rooms or receive a refund from Inspiration Hills.

*Will Refunds be allowed if canceled before July 30?*

Yes. See above.

*How can I help?*

We welcome anyone who'd like to help with retreat, through preparation, serving, or hospitality—please indicate your interest on the registration form. We encourage all attendees to balance serving with rest and receiving during the weekend. A list of opportunities will be shared with registrants as the retreat approaches.

*I have dietary concerns...*

There is a spot on the registration form to indicate your specific needs. We will give our best effort to accommodate these needs.

*What is the schedule for the retreat?*

The committee is in full swing planning a meaningful experience for you. We will have check-in at 4pm on Friday afternoon, followed by supper and an opening program. Saturday will include breakfast and lunch, with worship, speakers, break outs, and optional activities in-between. We will have a closing session mid-afternoon and conclude about 4pm on Saturday. Attendees who elect to stay for the second evening will share supper together and more free-flowing fellowship and rest time, with a casual breakfast on Sunday morning. A more detailed schedule will be shared this fall.
