I. THE ROLES OF JESUS

A. Prophet And FULFILLMENT Of Prophecy

Acts 3:18, 22 “But what God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer, he thus fulfilled...The Lord God will raise up for you a prophet...”

B. Both Priest And OFFERING

Hebrews 4:14, 7:27 “Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God... he did this [sacrifice] once for all when he offered up himself.”

C. A Descendent And LORD Of Kings

Luke 1:31–33 “And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus... And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David...and of his kingdom there will be no end.”

II. JESUS THE KING

A. The AUTHORITY To Rule

Revelation 19:16 “On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.”

B. The POWER To Rule

Isaiah 42:1–2 “Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations.”

C. The CHARACTER To Rule

Psalm 2:7–8 “You are my Son; today I have begotten you. Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.”

III. TRUSTING JESUS AS OUR KING

A. Learning To SUBMIT To Divine Authority

James 4:7 “Submit yourselves therefore to God.”

Hebrews 13:17 “Obey your leaders and submit to them,”

Romans 13:1 “Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.”

B. Adoption Into ROYALTY

Romans 8:15–17 “you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, “Abba! Father!” The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ”

THE NEXT FAITHFUL STEP

1. The Role of King. Discuss with your family and friends this week the strengths and weaknesses of having a governing king. Why does Jesus’ role as King not share the same weaknesses?

2. Learning to submit to Divine authority. Do you have a difficult time letting Jesus be King of your life? Take some time this week to surrender to God’s authority, letting Jesus fulfill his role as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
